A Low Speed Vehicle is a four wheeled, motor vehicle designed to operate at a speed of at least 20 but less than 25 miles per hour.

**Important Notice**

ALL MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED IN MARYLAND MUST BE INSURED BY A COMPANY LICENSED IN MARYLAND AND MUST HAVE PERSONAL INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY INSURANCE AT LEAST IN THE MINIMUM AMOUNTS REQUIRED BY MARYLAND LAW.

I/We certify that the vehicle involved in this transaction is classified as a Low Speed Vehicle:

- The Vehicle has a maximum speed of greater than 20 miles per hour, but less than 25 miles per hour;
- The Vehicle shall not be operated on a public highway with a speed limit in excess of 30 miles per hour;
- The Vehicle will not be operated in such a manner that would present a hazard or on roadways if it impedes traffic;
- The operator (driver) of the vehicle is subject to citations for impeding traffic;
- The vehicle identified above complies with all Federal Standards under 49C.F.R.571.500

If making application for new plates or transfer of registration plates I/We certify under Penalty of Law that the vehicle is covered by at least the minimum amount of insurance required by the Maryland Motor Vehicle Law, and further certify this vehicle will be continuously insured throughout its registration period. I/We further certify under Penalty of Perjury that the statements made herein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **What is a low speed vehicle?**

A low speed vehicle is a four-wheeled motor vehicle that:

Has a maximum speed capability that exceeds 20 miles per hour, but is less than 25 miles per hour;

Complies with the standards for safety of such a vehicle set forth in Federal Motor Safety Standard 49C.F.R.571.500.

### **NOTE: A GOLF CART IS NOT CONSIDERED A LOW SPEED VEHICLE**

### **Are low speed vehicles required to be titled and registered?**

Yes, Maryland law requires all low speed vehicles to be titled and registered.

### **Do I need a driver's license to operate a low speed vehicle on Maryland roadways?**

Yes, you must possess a valid driver's license to operate a low speed vehicle on Maryland roads.

### **Is a low speed vehicle restricted to only operating on roadways with certain speed limits?**

Yes, a person may not drive a low speed vehicle on a roadway for which the posted maximum speed limit exceeds 30 miles per hour; or on an expressway or another controlled access highway that is signed so as to prohibit the use of these type vehicles on its roadways.
