



This class is designed to coincide with a candidates' apprentice license. Candidates will attend class and then return to their school in between classes allowing for a period of co-teaching and mentoring. The theory being, what is taught in class can then be applied and practiced in a live classroom setting.

Candidates will then return to the advanced class where the results can be discussed and refined, allowing the candidates to not only learn from the instructor, but from their peers as well. Additionally, activity logs will be completed by the candidates during the course of this training.
