RE: CS-80 Inventory Stickers (“B” numbers)

It has recently been brought to the attention of the Administration the CS-80 pre numbered Wrecker stickers were printed with a control number consisting of an alpha “B” and 7 numeric. We have also been advised the AD&R and Scrap Processor’s data base will not accept more than 6 characters.

In order to eliminate destroying the current inventory, we have elected to continue with the issuance of the stickers. The process for entering the inventory into your databases will be to drop the first two zeros, start with the letter “B” and add the last five numbers on the sticker. For example, a CS-80 sticker displaying the number B0012345 should be entered as B12345 as the inventory number.

If this matter caused any duplication of numbers in your system, you will need to go back and change the new stickers to the format as stated above. The next CS-80 will be ordered with a 6 digit control number. I sincerely apologize for the inconvenience this matter has caused.
