Dr. Staplin is an experimental psychologist who has served as principal investigator on over 30 research projects, with a strong focus on the relationship between age-related changes in driver functional abilities and traffic safety. Significant products of his work in this area include the *Safe Mobility for Older People Notebook*; the *Highway Design Handbook for Older drivers and Pedestrians*; the *Model Driver Screening and Evaluation Program: Guidelines for Motor Vehicle Administrators*; and two chapters in the 2004 Transportation Research Board (TRB) publication, *Transportation in an Aging Society: A Decade of Experience*.
