Social workers play an integral role in coaching older adults to make good decisions about driving safety, and this workshop will identify resources for effective programs. The issue is not about being older, but the physical and cognitive issues with aging that impact on safe driving. Lectures and discussions will focus on this and on the psychological issues related to driving, the features of effective conversation about transitioning from driving, and identifying medically at-risk drivers, including awareness of MVA's medical review process.
