RE: **Temporary Plate Reminder**

Please be advised, the Motor Vehicle Administration has notified Law Enforcement that effective October 1, 2013, the former 60 day temporary plate displayed in a plastic bag is no longer valid. The new Teflon coated 60-day temporary plate is the only one authorized by this administration to be issued by selling dealerships.

To avoid any problems, please ensure that you have the new paper stock available for use and that you are no longer issuing the obsolete plate to vehicle purchasers. All 60 day temporary plates must be printed on the new stock utilizing a laser jet printer.
